## Plan your trip



### HOW TO GET AROUND?

For the summit area, from lakeshore e-biking to hiking along the route in this pamphlet, the best way to get around is by electric power-assisted bicycle, available to hire online in advance. Most of the area is also within walking distance. Fujimi Onsen, Ogo and beyond are accessible by bus and local train. For those with large luggage or who want to explore more, hiring a car near Takasaki Station is also a good option (make sure to bring an international driving license).

### WHAT SHOULD I DO?

Mt. Akagi has beautiful hiking trails for all levels, and both the summit and lower areas of the mountain are great for cycling. You can go snowshoeing and ice fishing in the winter or pedal boating on the caldera lake in the warmer months. There are spectacular opportunities for flower viewing, with cherry blossoms at Akagi Senbon Zakura (Thousand Cherry Blossom Lane) and several seasonal flower gardens at Gunma Flower Park.

### WHEN IS BEST TO GO?

There are many activities all-year-round so you won't be disappointed no matter when you visit. In late spring and early summer you can see Akagi's famous azaleas blooming all over the mountain. It's always about 10°C cooler up around the summit area, so it's a great place to escape the heat in the summer. Akagi is a great spot for fall foliage viewing, and from January to March there are opportunities for snowshoeing and ice fishing.
